

**The following is a list of unacceptable behavior and the consequences of such behavior:**

**The following list explains the consequences based on the point system:**

	<b>INFRACTION</b>	Pts.
1	Insubordination to a teacher, administrator or staff member	<b>2</b>
2	Use of profane/obscene language	<b>2</b>
3	Destroying/defacing school property	<b>4</b>
4	Committing an act that degrades, disgraces another person	<b>2</b>
5	Committing an act that injures a person	<b>3</b>
6	Improper approach to the opposite sex	<b>4</b>
7	Possession of obscene materials e.g. pornographic materials, etc	<b>1</b>
8	Possession of matches, knives, weapons, or any dangerous instruments	<b>3</b>
9	Possession of prescription/non-prescription drugs without permission	<b>3</b>
10	Improper attire (e.g. not wearing uniform except gym clothes or "Dress Down: Fridays for \$1.00) during school hours	<b>1</b>
11	Possession of another student's property e.g. stealing	<b>1</b>
12	Any act that goes against the basic moral values of our society	<b>1</b>
13	Leaving the premises without permission	<b>2</b>
14	Breaking any general rules listed in handbook	<b>1</b>

Pts.	<b>DISCIPLINARY ACTION</b>
<b>1-2</b>	Student will be counseled for unacceptable behavior and parents will be contacted
<b>3-5</b>	One day suspension
<b>6-8</b>	Two days suspension
<b>9</b>	One week suspension
<b>10+</b>	<b>Expulsion</b>
*	<b>Causing bodily harm will result in automatic suspension.</b>
*	<b>All suspensions will be indicated on the child's permanent record. The child must also be accompanied by his/her parent or legal guardian as indicated on record before acceptance to the school.</b>
*	<b>Tuition will not be refunded if your child was expelled from school or for the suspension period.</b>
*	<b>Any faculty member has the right to correct an unruly individual, but no parent should correct any student other than their own child. Problems should instead be reported to the school office.</b>
